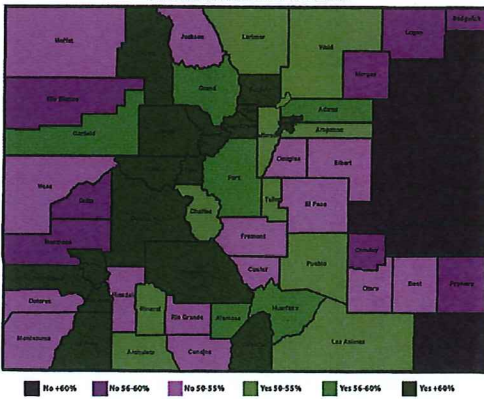
Legal Status of Marijuana in the United States as of 12/14



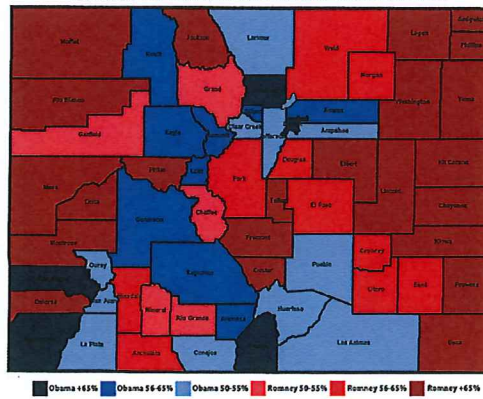

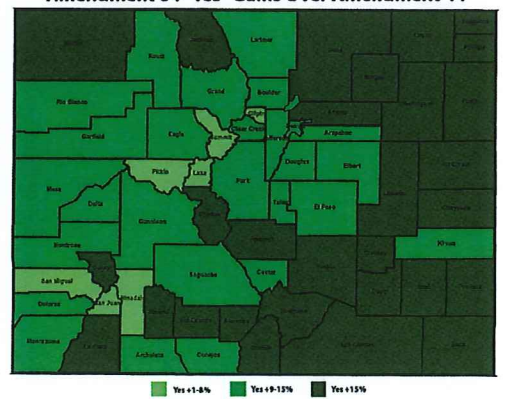

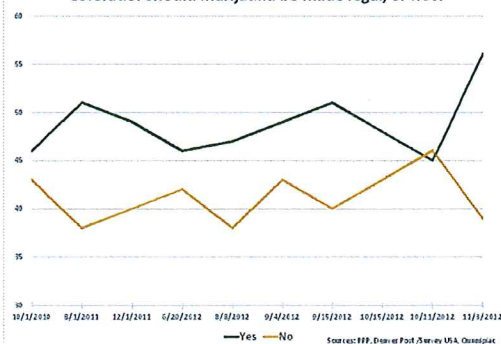
